Annual School Board Report

Council focused on reestablishment and reorganization. The past Council had become inactive. By-laws and strategic plan (includes; Mission, Vision, Goals, Objectives, and Activities) are posted on the website

We have held three meetings to date. Have one more meeting scheduled before school is out. Minutes of the meetings will be posted on the school website.

1<sup>st</sup> Meeting was devoted to review of local and state policy, and the laws governing SHAC's. Additional topics were: appointment of parents to council, discussion of the teen pregnancy problems.

2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting focused on brain storming about avenues of action to address the increasing teen pregnancy rate at Hart High School. Committee appointed to study and write recommendations.

3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting discussed committee recommendations. Reviewed grant application and appointed a committee to complete the application.

April 12, 2010 - Met with school Board and made recommendations.

- Continue HS Health class as a local credit;
- Implement a required parenting class for pregnant and parenting students;
- Implement a structured sex/character education program with regular planned activities, including classroom and assembly.

Next scheduled meeting is April 20.

Currently have two committees active. One is working on a grant to support SHAC activities. The grant is due April 15, to be implemented before May 15 ending Nov. 30 in the amount of \$4500. The second committee is focusing on addressing the alarming teen pregnancy rate.

Future Committee to meet this summer and research sex education curriculums and programs for 2010-11 school year.
